

YOKE SWEATER

Yarn: Isokummun kehräämö (Spinnery), 3-s Päivikki, tex 180x3, 185m/100g. 100% Finnish, 100% wool, 100% toxic free, 100% spinning oil free. www.isokummun.com

-main color 450 (550) 650 (700) g -contrast color 150 (150) 200 (200) g

Suggested needles: double pointed needles, circular needles 30cm and 60-80 cm size 4 and 4,5 or size needed to get gauge 18 sts x 23 rnds = 10 cm x 10 cm

Also needed: stitch markers

It is recommended to knit a sample piece of stockinette knit from which you measure the knitting density. If there are more stitches in the sample than the recommended knitting density, change to thinner needles. If less, change needles to thicker ones. One colored sections can be knitted with 0.5 mm thinner needles than colorwork. The ribbings can be knitted with needles 1 - 1.5 mm thinner.

Construction note: The sweater is knitted from top to bottom seamless, starting from the collar ribbing with raise back neck (if wanted). First, we knit a yoke, from which the sleeves and the hem are separated.

Sizes, about 5 cm looseness: XS/ S bust 90 cm, M bust 99 cm, L bust 117 cm, XL bust 132 cm

Measurements (circumference): Ribbings 5 cm, Shoulder to hem 65 (70) 75 (80) cm, Sleeve Length from cuff to armpit 45 (47) 49 (51) cm, Circle after the yoke 33 (37) 43 (47) cm, Wrist circumference 22 (22) 25 (25) cm

The height on the yoke before separating the sleeves and hem, measured the front, including the ribbings: about 25 (25) 26 (26) cm

The circumference of the yoke Fromond the bottom edge: 132 (151) 175 (193) cm

The entire height of the hem from the armpit: 48 (50) 52 (54) cm

Hem pattern height: 18 cm (+ribbing, about 5 cm) **Hem circumference:** 95 (104) 122 (132) cm

Collar: Cast on 80 (90) 100 (110) sts on a short circular needle. Close into a ring, add a marker at the beginning of the row. **Knit ribbing:** knit 1, purl 1, a total of 12 rows.

Back raise: (You can also skip this raise completely, wich allows you to go directly to the yoke section.) Knit the ribbon back and forth, purl purl stitches and knit knitted stitches. **Right row:** Knit 8 (8) 10 (10) sts, turn work, tighten up yarn around the needle.

Back row: Knit to the beginning of the layer and then yet 8 (8) 10 (10) sts. Turn work, tighten up yarn around the needle.

Right row: Knit to the beginning of the layer, 8 (8) 10 (10) sts in the last one, both the loop and the yarn loop of the turning point correctly together, knit yet 8 (8) 10 (10) sts, Turn work, tighten up yarn around the needle.

Back row: Knit to the beginning of the layer, 8 (8) 10 (10) sts. In the last one, both the loop and the yarn loop of the turning point correctly together. Knit yet 8 (8) 10 (10) sts, Turn work, tighten up yarn around the needle.

Right row: Knit to the beginning of the layer.

Yoke: Knit one row, knitting the loop and stitch together at the turning point (if you knit an raise. Decrease 4 (6) 8 (10) sts. 84 (96) 108 (120) sts evenly.

Start the yoke chart, A.

Place a marker at the beginning of the work, knit pattern of the diagram once, place a marker. Knit the pattern of the chart 7 (8) 9 (10) times, place a marker at the change point of each pattern.

On the first layer, there are 12 stitches in the chart and 6 stitches are increased, a total of 18s/one pattern of the chart. After the first row there are 126 (144) 162 (180) sts on the needles.

Knit rows 1 to 41. Note! Replace longer circular needles as needed.

On row 41 there are a total of 238 (272) 306 (340) stitches. Knit 1 row with the main color, increase 10 (6) 10 (8) sts evenly at on the layer. There are now 248 (278) 316 (348) stitches. Remove the other markers, but leave the marker at the beginning of the row.

Continue knitting round stockinette with the main color until the height of the yoke is 25 (25) 26 (26) cm.

Separate the sleeves and hem: Back piece 37 (41) 47 (52) sts from the beginning of the layer and 38(42)48(52) sts from the end of the layer. Sleeve 49 (56) 63 (70) sts. Front piece 75 (83) 95 (104) sts. Second sleeve 49 (56) 63 (70) sts. Transfer the stitches of the sleeves to the auxiliary yarn etc to wait.

The hem of the front and back: Continue with stockinette stitch for the hem.

Move the starting point of the round to the center of the underarm, to the beginning of the back hem: Create for the armpit 5 (5) 8 (8) new stitches. Knit 75 (83) 95 (104) sts for the back piece, create 10 (10) 15 (15) new stitches for the second armpit. Knit the front piece 75 (83) 95 (104) sts, create another 5 (5) 7 (7) new stitches for the first armpit, close in a circle. The needles now have 170 (186) 220 (238) sts. When you have knitted the hem 25 (27) 29 (30) cm, knit 1 row adding 0 (1) 1(0) sts. (170(187)221(238)s).

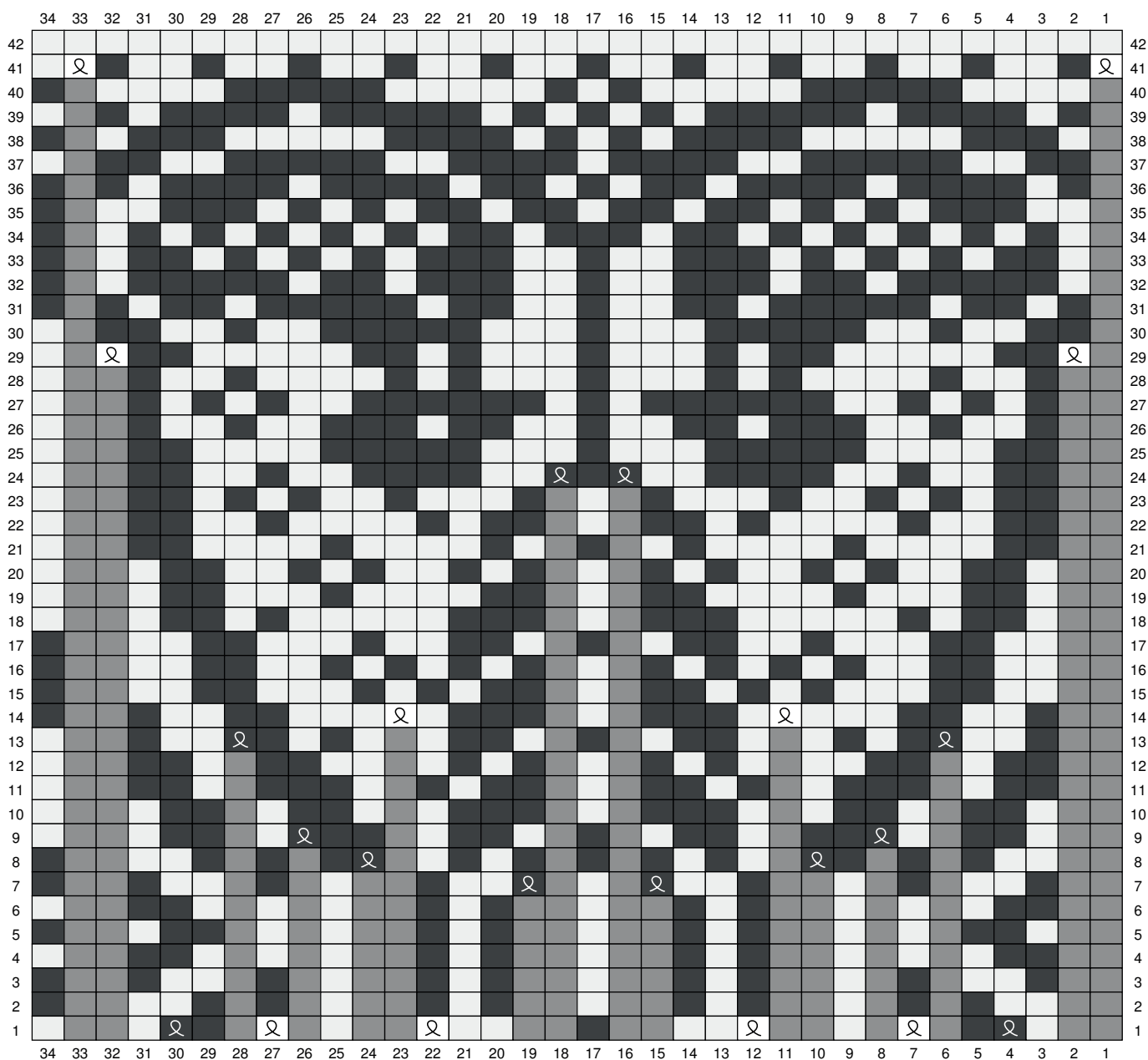
Start chart B of the hem. Knit stitches 1-17 of the chart 5 (6) 7 (8) times, knit stitches 18-51(museum chart), knit stitches 52-68 3 (3) 4 (4) times. The museum chart should be in front of the right. Or without museum chart: Knit stitches 1-17 of the chart a total of 10 (11) 13 (14) times. When you have knitted layers 1-42 of the chart, knit 1 row and decrease 10 (15) 15 (15) sts evenly. Knit 1 right, 1 purl ribbing for hem, in total 12 rows. Bind off the stitches, fasten off.

Sleeves: Take 49 (56) 63 (70) stitches for the sleeve and pick up 10 (10) 15 (15) sts from the stitches created for the armpit. Note! You can pick up 12 sts if necessary if it looks like there will be holes on the edges. In this case, knit the first 2 and last 2 stitches together on the first layer.

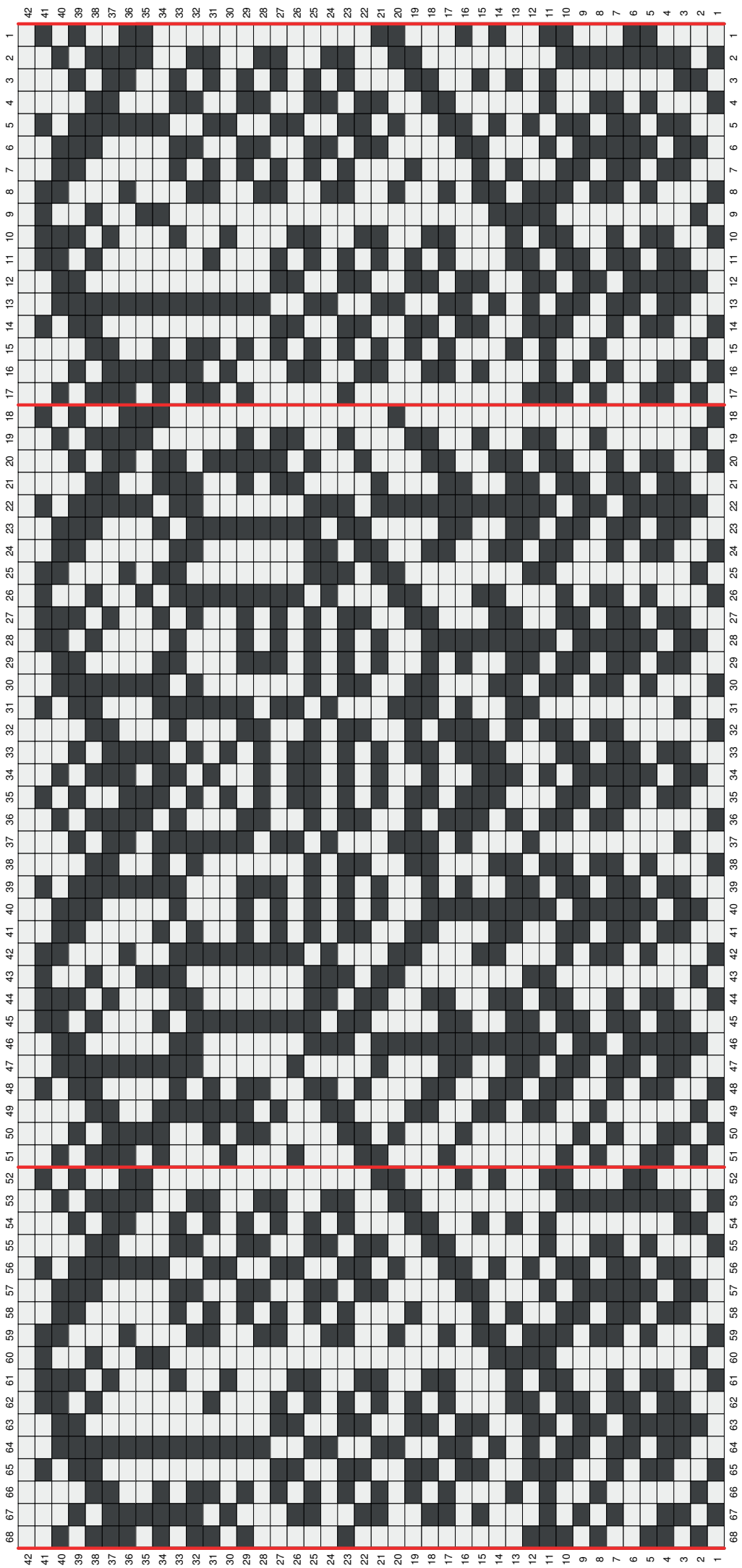
There are now 59 (66) 78 (85) stitches. Knit the sleeve with the main color. The change point of the row is now the middle of the stitches created in the armpit, put a marker there. After knitting 2 (1) 2 (1) cm, start decreasing rounds.

From the beginning of the layer, knit 1 sts, knit 2 sts together. When there are 3 sts left on the row, pass slipped stitch over, 1 sts. Repeat the decreases evenly 3.5 (3) 2.5 (2) cm a total of 9 (13) 16 (20) times. When the sleeve length is 40 (42) 44 (46) cm, decrease on the last right row before rib 1 (0) 1 (0) sts. There are 40 (40) 45 (45) stitches. Knit 1, purl 1 ribbing for 12 rows, bind off the stitches, fasten off. Knit the other sleeve in the same way.

Finishing: Conclude the yarns. Moisten the knitwear and let it dry on a flat surface.
